This role involves coaching and mentoring students in preparation for Varsity level competition.

Job Duties :

- Plan, organize and lead high-quality practices that develop athletes' technical and physical abilities in preparation for competition. Ability to instruct students and manage their behaviors.
- Demonstrates a strong knowledge of rowing techniques, strategy and team dynamics to lead and organize the team.
- Ability to rig and launch boats.
- Inspire and motivate student-athletes, fostering passion for the sport and personal growth.
- Communicate clearly and consistently about team expectations with the ability to connect effectively with high school athletes.
- Communicates regularly and effectively on team needs with the Athletic Department.
- Ensures compliance with regulations having a thorough knowledge of Athletic Department, Founder's League and NEPSAC policies.
