Job Summary:

Seeking a responsible and attentive Lifeguard to ensure the safety and well-being of all patrons in and around the Miss Porter's School pool. The ideal candidate is alert, physically capable, and committed to maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment through proactive supervision and quick response to emergencies.

Key Responsibilities:

- Monitor pool activities continuously to ensure the safety of all swimmers and guests
- Enforce pool rules and regulations in a professional and consistent manner
- Respond quickly and effectively to emergencies by following established Emergency Action Plans (EAPs) and facility procedures, including performing water rescues and administering first aid or CPR/AED as necessary.
- Complete accident, incident, and rescue reports accurately and in a timely manner as required
- Maintain a clean and safe pool environment by identifying, reporting and addressing potential hazards
- Provide excellent customer service and communicate effectively with others
- Participate in regular safety drills, in-service training and team meetings
- Work collaboratively with team members while also demonstrating the ability to work independently
- Maintain appropriate professional boundaries with students

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Available to work a flexible schedule, including weekdays, evenings and weekends
- Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR/AED and First Aid must be maintained throughout employment
- Strong swimming skills and physical ability to perform rescues and respond in emergency situations
- Ability to remain alert, attentive and focused for extended periods
- Prior lifeguarding or aquatic experience (preferred but not required)
